#### WiN China and WiN Russia Teleconference



WiN China and WiN Russia held the first-ever teleconference on February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025. The parties established friendship, introduced the development of nuclear power in China and the 2023-2030 Russia's national action strategy for women, highlighting each chapter's activities and contributions to global nuclear progress.

Consensus was reached on appointing designated contacts and sharing information about international activities such as STEM courses and the BRICS "Green Future" project, and potential for future bilateral cooperation was explored.





#### **WANO Information Security Training**



A legal training session was conducted by Ms. Li Zhaohui, Legal Adviser of CNNC, on March 3, 2025 for WANO Shanghai, followed by planned participation in IAEA's INLEX annual meeting as an expert, along with coordinating a CAEA-IAEA workshop on national atomic energy legislation organized by CNNC.

The training covered nuclear energy industry information security regulations and international compliance management experiences, aiming to enhance awareness among nuclear professionals.

Participants learned about confidentiality and export control laws, which are crucial for maintaining secure operations within the nuclear sector.





#### SNERDI "She Power" Activities





13 female model workers, artisans, and provincial/ministerial-level outstanding women representatives were accredited with the establishment of innovation studios. These efforts aim to build the "728 Innovation Studio" brand and implement a "Three-Tier Ascension" mechanism. By organizing various innovation exchange activities, a strong innovation-driven atmosphere has been cultivated, resulting in over a hundred provincial/ministerial-level employee innovation achievement awards.

Shanghai Nuclear Engineering Research & Design Institute Co., Ltd. (SNERDI) hosted the "She Power" event (March 6, 2025), celebrating women's contributions in nuclear energy through awards, inspirational stories, family workshops, and wellness programs, while honoring female innovators and supporting work-life balance.

#### **Women in Tech Forum**

The Luo Ying Innovation Studio at Nuclear Power Institute of China has launched the Women in Tech forum, with the inaugural session held on April 11, 2025 in Chengdu, Sichuan.

The forum featured technical reports on advanced nuclear energy and reactor technologies, delving into the breadth and depth of nuclear science and technology. Additionally, it included an open discussion on "Al for Women in Nuclear Science", showcasing the global vision and cuttingedge leadership of female scientists and engineers in the nuclear sector.
