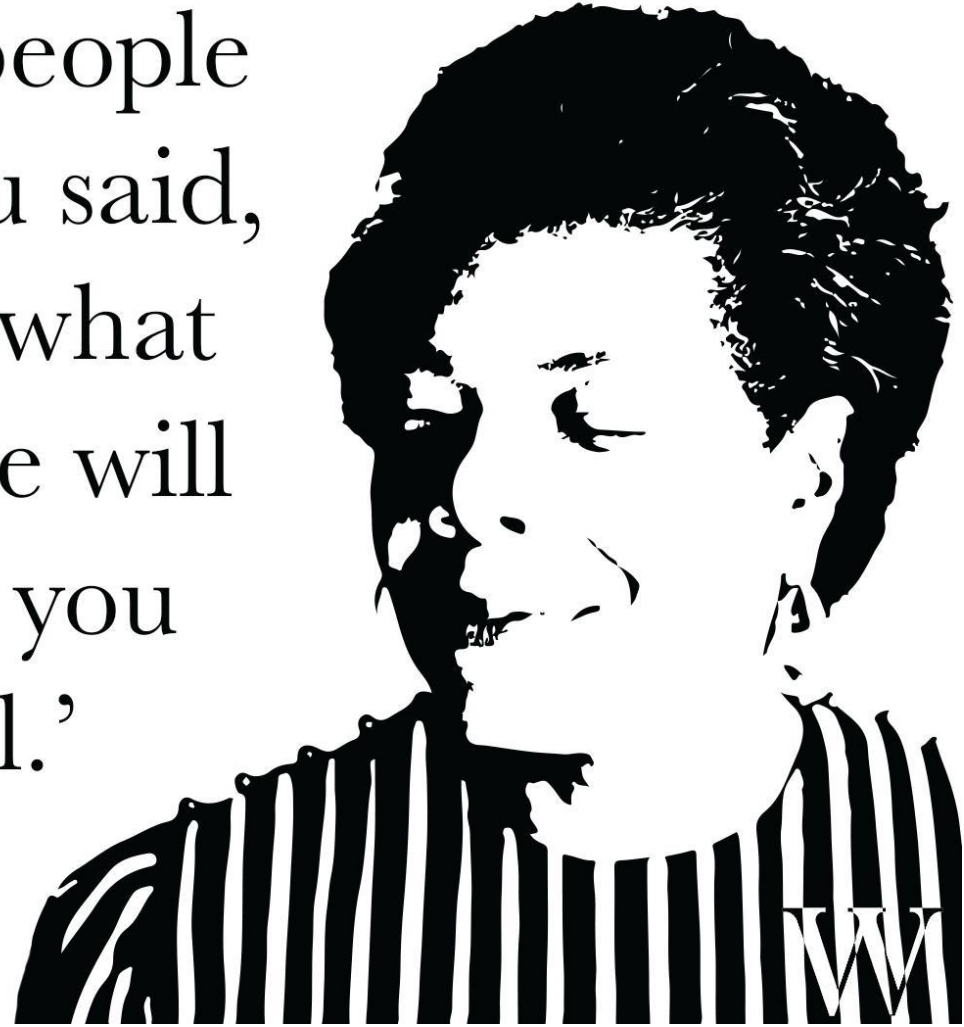

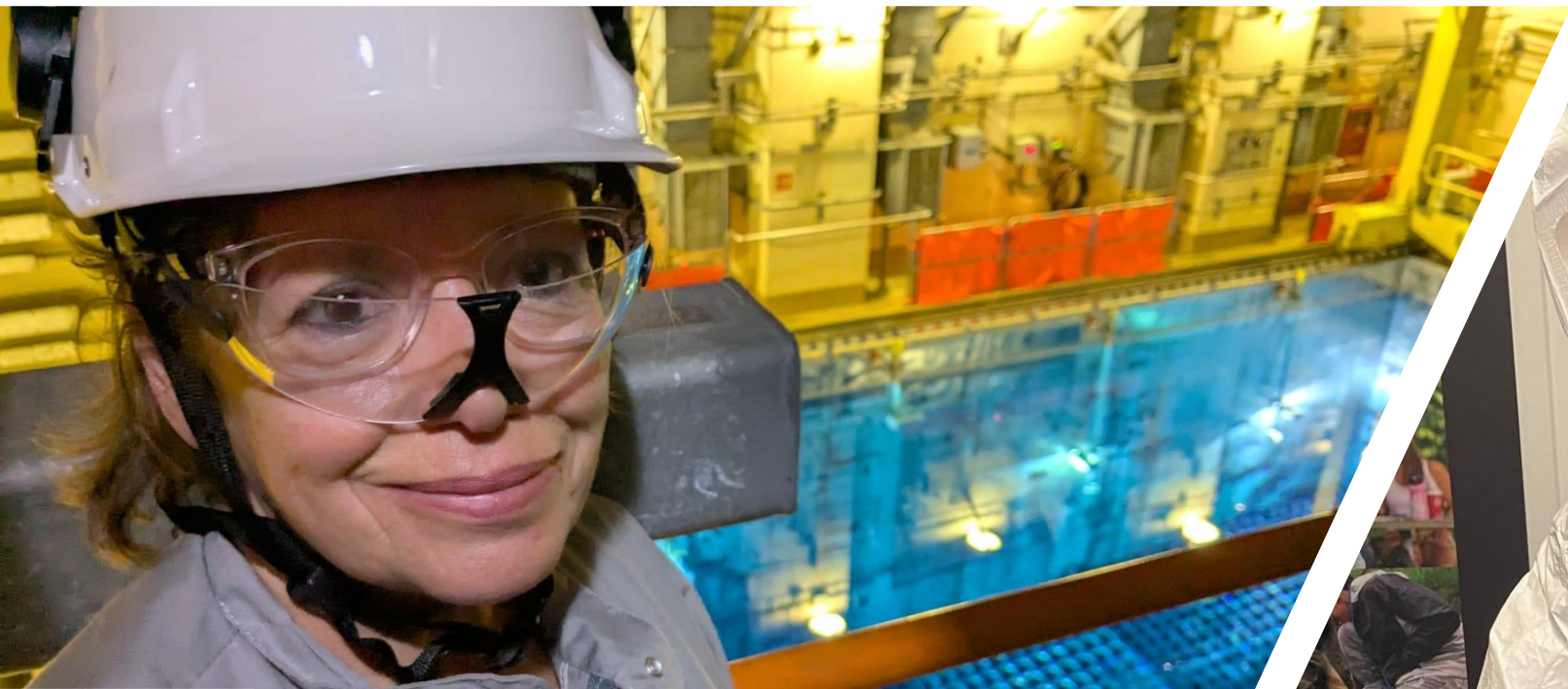

If Indonesia's research reactor fuel can already make its own fuel.

- The facilities in Indonesia are uranium mining in West Kalimantan, leaching and extraction from rocks, then there are purification facilities in South Jakarta [Pasar Jumat] and separation of uranium from plutonium in Jogjakarta, there are pulse column tools and mixer settlers, then in Serpong there are facilities for making yellow cake for fuel or assembling power reactor fuel, but these facilities need to be updated and developed and studied.

Workshop Cooperation Between WIN Indonesian, Urenco Magnox and WIN UK

- After meeting with the woman in nuclear United Kingdom and Urenco and Magnox, an idea emerged that for the sake of cooperation in improving the skills and insight of human resources, the younger generation should be prioritized to obtain mentoring and guidance on nuclear fuel in my country for the younger generation in the future to increase their insight and benefits of nuclear technology, especially nuclear fuel for electricity.
- Proposal for cooperation in organizing workshops and guidance and mentoring for uranium processing from Urenco and Magnox to fuel for power reactors.

10% transgender women.



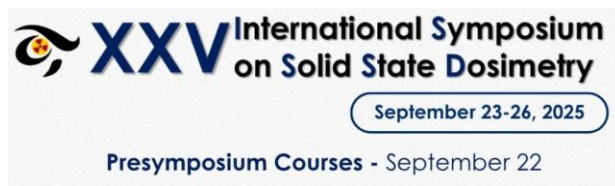
April - September 2025
